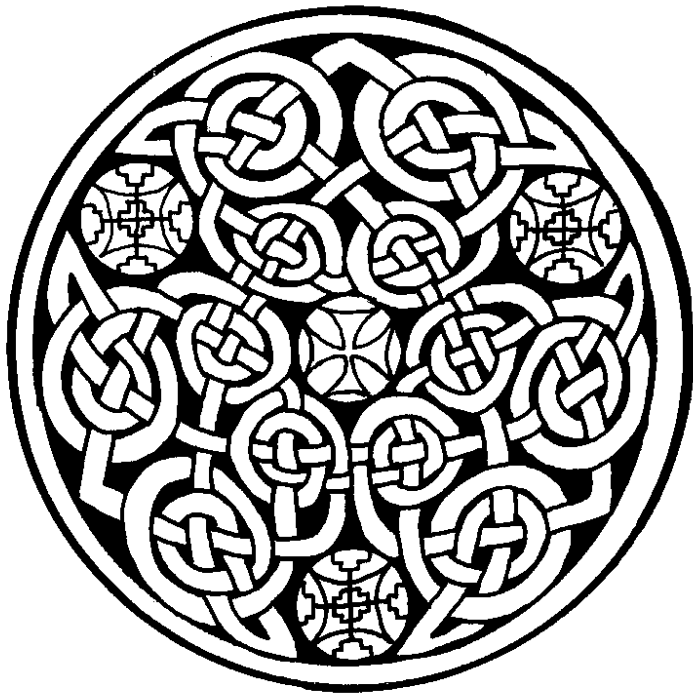


Choral Evensong in Lent

than /honey/in the/comb.

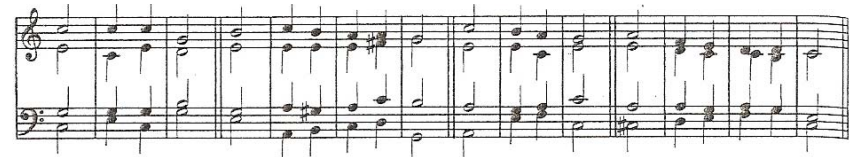
11 By them also is your/servant en/lightened, *
